Jillian West is a Mother, Aunty, Grandmother, Sister and Daughter. Most of all she is a proud Bunurong woman from Point Nepean and Palawa from the Islands of Bass Strait. Jill has a lengthy career supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in work, education and their life journey, and is strongly committed to working alongside community organisations, developing partnerships, and building cultural capacity. Jill strives to give Aboriginal people a voice through mentoring, employment and education with the aim of closing the gap.

Since May 2021 the Yoorrook Justice Commission has led Victoria's formal truth-telling inquiry into historic injustices caused by colonisation and ongoing systemic injustices still experienced by First Peoples in this State. Jill's presentation is vital in helping us understand the historical impact of these injustices and reflect on Truth-Telling in our local context.
